Available in a variety of styles and proportions, they can complement the surrounding architecture while giving your structure a more customized, finished appearance.

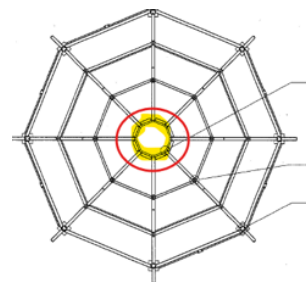
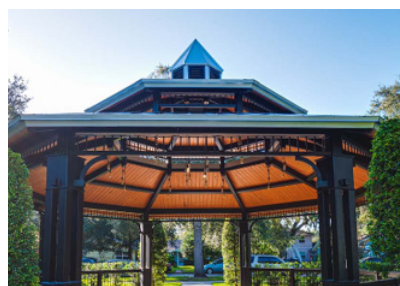
Sheet Metal Non-Venting: (CMA/ CMB / CMC) - Non-functional

This sheet metal cupola provides the classic look of a traditional cupola while serving as a purely decorative architectural element. Featuring decorative louvers, the cupola is finished in the roof color, while the louvers are powder coated to match the frame color.



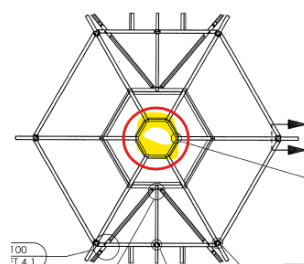
Framed Vented: (CVA / CVB / CVC) - Functional

These cupolas feature structural framing that integrates with the building frame. The roof beneath the cupola is also framed, creating an open view into the cupola from below. Finishes match the structure, with frame and roof colors coordinated throughout.



Framed Vented w/ or w/o Ornamentation: (CFB, CFC) - Functional

These cupolas incorporate structural framing within both the cupola and shelter, creating an open view into the cupola from below. This design provides a clerestory-inspired look and can be enhanced with optional decorative ornamentation. Colors match the shelter's roof and frame, with ornamentation typically finished in the frame color unless otherwise specified.
