Poligon partnered with Zeeland High School to design and deliver a custom covered walkway canopy that enhances both functionality and school pride. The structure was installed to provide students and staff protection from Michigan's unpredictable weather as they travel between campus buildings. Spanning approximately 15 feet wide and 750 feet long, the canopy creates a safe, well-lit, and clearly defined pathway that improves daily circulation across campus. Designed with integrated lighting and custom school branding, the project not only shields students from rain and snow but also reinforces the school's identity. The result is a durable, architecturally cohesive solution that supports comfort, safety, and long-term campus value.



The galvanized and powder-coated steel construction helps resist corrosion and reduce maintenance costs an important benefit for school districts focused on long-term budgets.

The extended-span design minimizes columns to improve pedestrian flow, ADA accessibility, and visibility for supervision. Integrated drainage manages rain and snow runoff to reduce slip hazards and keep entrances cleaner. Designed with future expansion in mind, the project reflects close collaboration between Poligon's engineering team and school stakeholders to create a safe, efficient, and cohesive campus solution.
